

CWS GENERAL MEETING MINUTES  
January 19, 2010  
First Plymouth Congregational Church, Denver

CALL TO ORDER: President Sydney Eitel called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

-Sydney announced that 58 artists from CWS had entered paintings into the WFWS Show to be held in Utah May 14 to June 28, and that 20 members had been accepted.

MEMBERSHIP: Carla Rouse announced that CWS now had 449 members. She requested that members send her any address changes and website addresses for CWS website.

PROGRAMS: Paul Foster explained that tonight's program would be a panel of CWS volunteers who will provide tips about showing artwork. Serving on this panel were Chuck Danford, Kate Wyman, Donna Lee Clemenson, David Kuhune and Pat Carney. Paul Foster was monitor.

-The February meeting will be held at RedLine Gallery on Saturday, February 13 with a snow date of February 20. A new show entitled *Lovelines*, analyzing love in its many aspects, will be on display. There are twelve separate studios in the gallery where CWS members may view artists at work; they may view the gallery show on their own. Paul explained that some of the art is rather "edgy." People may park in a small parking lot or on the street.

-The March program will be a talk given by Nancy Boyson on the business of art.

-At the November critique, two members received a \$30 Best of Show award from FMS Digital for a digital image; Naum Katsenelson already picked up his and now Sharon Wink may collect hers.

WORKSHOPS: Terrey Harrod summarized the upcoming workshops as follows:

-Ratindra Das, juror for the Colorado State Watermedia Show, will conduct a workshop March 1-5, 2010 at the Colorado Mills Mall. The cost for members is \$375 and for nonmembers is \$425. There are ten slots open. A drawing for a scholarship from among those registered will be made before the workshop.

-Michael Atkinson will hold a workshop from April 19-23; it is one-half full.

-Gene Youngmann will conduct a plein air workshop June 4-6.

-Ted Nuttall will hold a workshop July 9-11, 2010. It is already three-fourths full.

-Peggy Morgan Stenmark will teach an ink resist workshop September 10-12.

-Stan Miller is scheduled to teach a workshop October 18-22, 2010 entitled *Portraits, Landscapes, Composition and Design*.

Virginia Cobb's workshop will be held in late October or early November

-Tom Owen is scheduled to teach January 14-16, 2011.

-Additional workshops planned for 2011 include Birgit O'Connor and Anne Bagby. Details for these will be printed in the *Collage* when they become available.
