# Scam Artists Scamming Artists

Two stories to raise our consciousness:

Artist A: "I received an email expressing interest in three of my pieces of art off the Colorado Artist Register. They sent me a check that included the full amount plus shipping. This check was good enough it fooled the young bank teller. She was counting out the money to me, (since I had an account at Wells Fargo they will do that with the understanding if there is any fraud they come back to you.) I suggested we investigate the check. She called me later that day and verified that the check was not good. I received a call from "Linda Smith" asking if I had received the check. My answer was 'yes it wasn't good'. She hung up."

Artists B who is a CWS member:
"I recently was contacted by someone via email who wanted to buy 4 paintings. The would-be purchaser had a run around about a second party check she would sign over and would I deposit the check and just send her the extra amount."

Luckily this artist was also smart enough to see the scam.

Also when you register your domain name, you have to give an address but you can have it masked so that your address is not available to everyone. It cost about \$5.00 more but worth it. At least you are then in control of who you give you address and phone number to. I think it is wise to use a P.O. Box for transactions. Nancy Lund






